

Vanderbilt Drive Cul-de-sacs Public Utilities Renewal

February 8, 2019

Dear Residents of Phases 4A, 4B and 5 Vanderbilt Drive Cul-de-sacs,

The Vanderbilt Drive Cul-de-sacs project is now working on the final phases of the project – 4A, 4B and 5. Please see map attached. This notification will clarify road detours and closures within the project during these final phases.

The “Local Traffic Only” sign at the intersection of 91st Avenue N and Vanderbilt Drive has been there since the start of Phase 3. We have not removed it yet because the contractor is still working on driveways and general restoration activities in Phase 3. We have contacted the Sheriff’s Office to monitor careless driving in the area.

Since Phase 4B has started, the crews are working on the water and stormwater pipes. The contractor is closing a block at a time as he advances from south to north. Right now the closure is between 101st and 102nd Avenues N, and they will progress in this manner until we reach 107th Avenue N. After the block-by-block water and stormwater work is complete (estimated in April 2019), the contractor will work on the wastewater pipe installation in the middle of the road, requiring the entire Phase 4B to be closed with a detour through Naples Park.

There are two other “Local Traffic Only” signs on 107th and 105th Avenues N for drivers coming from the north end of Vanderbilt Drive. The attached map shows these closures.

We appreciate the residents’ patience while we complete these final phases of this project.

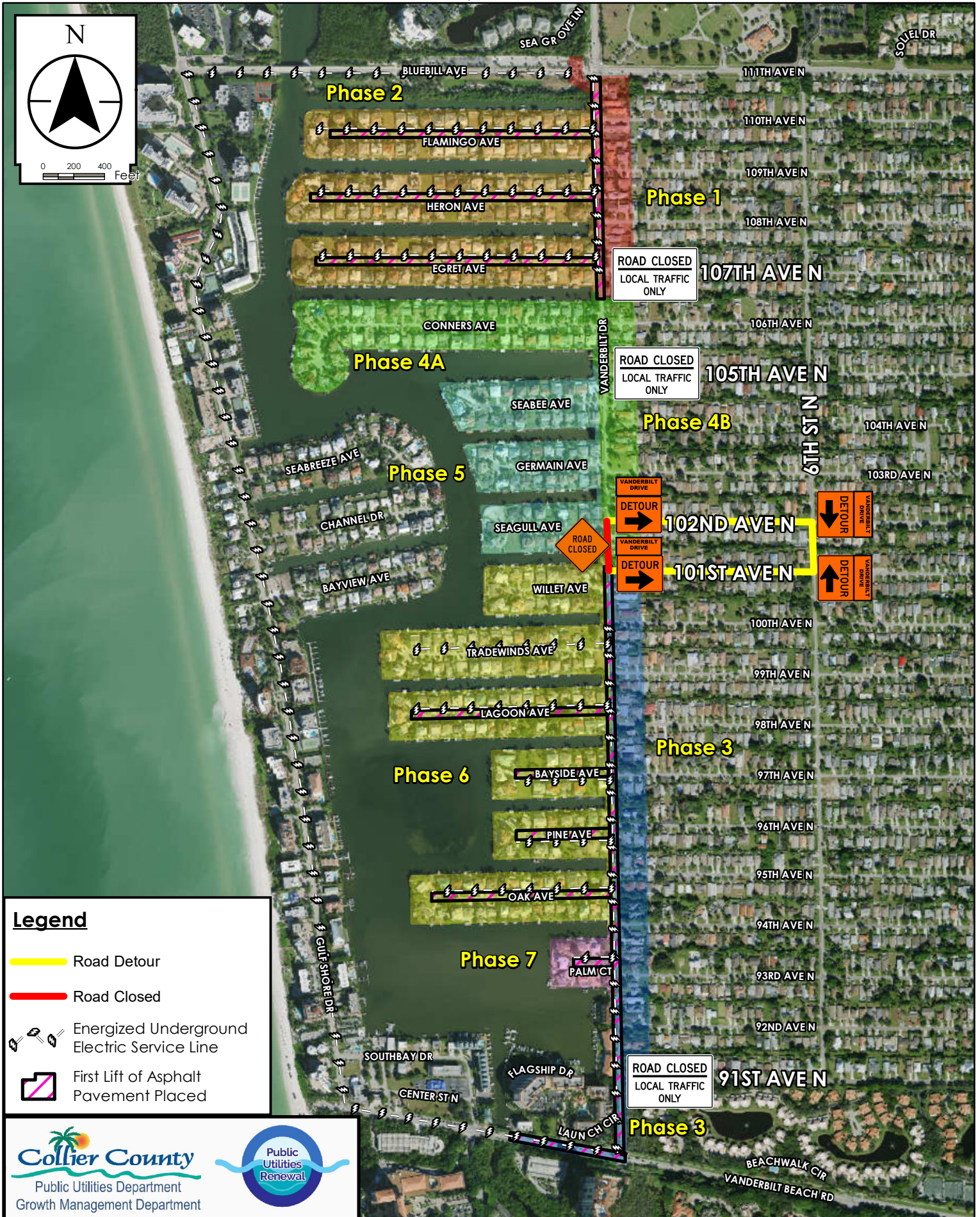
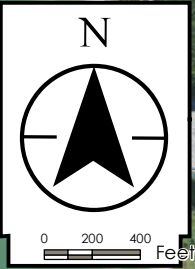
