

Greetings,

This email is to inform you that the County will be replacing a wastewater force main under Vanderbilt Channel. This project is necessary to ensure reliable wastewater services can be provided to the area. As part of this project, construction activities will occur on either side of the Channel. On the west side of the Channel - in the area east of the main entrance of Vanderbilt Towers, just south of the Baypoint Towers parking lot and on the east side of the Channel - in the area west of and along the sidewalk north of the County owned parking lot.

Construction is expected to begin in August 2019. Work is expected to be completed within 90 days, barring unforeseen conditions or weather-related delays. Work will not occur before 7 AM or after 7 PM, nor will it occur on Sundays or legal holidays, except in emergencies.

The contractor will ensure that residents can access their homes during construction. Minor changes to traffic patterns should be expected, but the contractor will take steps to minimize inconveniences. In addition, the contractor has been instructed to maintain a clean work site and ensure all materials and equipment are safely stored during non-working hours.

Any impacts on roads, parking areas, sidewalks, landscaping, grass, etc. will be repaired restored as close as possible to the condition that currently exists. However, residents should expect to see temporary aesthetic changes to these items during construction.

Our team has and will continue to minimize inconveniences for residents. This is an important project to replace an old pipeline that is approaching the end of its useful life. The new pipeline will ensure that reliable services are provided and the environment is protected. Thank you for your help in making this project a success.
